Themed learning project: Rocks, Relics and Rumbles.

This is a geography project which teaches children about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity. We will be joining up children's growing knowledge of Earth's processes by investigating different types of rocks, looking into how soil is formed and what we can learn from fossils.

As well as English and Maths, the main subjects we will be focussing on within the theme are:

- Art and Design Ammonite, People and Places
 - Design Technology Making it Move
- History The prehistoric periods: Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age
 - Science Rocks and soil, Forces

We will also have lessons in Music, Computing, French, RE, PE and PSHE.
